






The "Mobility" Sector



Engineering Innovation Hub

- Phase 1: ~ 10,000 sf / Summer 2020
- State-of the-art equipment and expertise to further educational and regional industry advancement
- Advanced Equipment to include, e.g.
 - 5-axis CNC Turning Centers
 - Ceramics 3D Printer
 - Advanced Metal 3D Printer
 - Water jet and laser cutters
- Part of a broader "maker" ecosystem with Center for Materials Fabrication and Nanotechnology, West Lake Industrial Design Studio, etc.
